Grendal

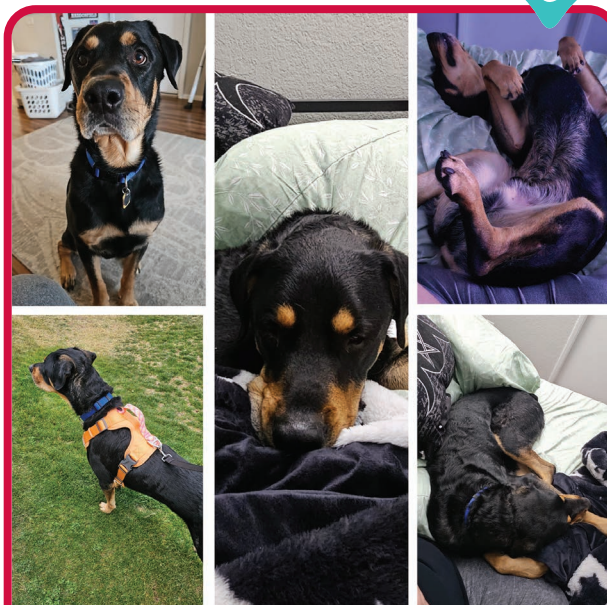

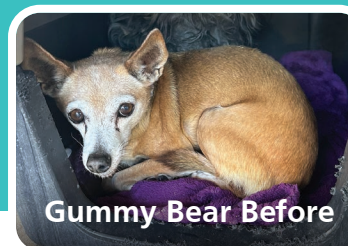
